## **CHANCELLOR ANITA BROWN RECEIVES LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

**Concord, NC, February 13, 2008-** Anita Brown, Chancellor of Cabarrus College of Health Sciences was recently honored by the Cabarrus Regional Chamber of Commerce, receiving the Lifetime Achievement Award for citizenship and service. The award was presented at the Chamber's annual meeting on Friday, January 18.

Chancellor Brown has served as the lead administrator at Cabarrus College since 1979 and chancellor since 1994. During her time as chancellor Cabarrus College has grown from a diploma nursing school to a health sciences college offering five associate degree programs, three bachelor's degree programs and enrolling over 420 students.

Chancellor Brown has held leadership positions with the National League for Nursing and its Accrediting Commission; NC Nurses Association; NC League for Nursing; American Health Sciences Education Consortium; NC Alliance of Hospital Based Schools of Nursing; and she has served as an accreditation reviewer for the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools – Commission on Colleges.

Chancellor Brown's contributions have extended well beyond the College. Her involvement in the community has included the United Way of Cabarrus County (serving as a member of the board of directors and the executive committee, and as campaign chairman of the Carolinas in 1996); the Cabarrus County Rotary Club (serving as president in 2001-02); serving on the board of the Cooperative Christian Ministry since 2001 (serving as president in 2006 & 07); and the Cabarrus Regional Chamber of Commerce (serving on the Workforce Development Steering Committee). She has also served as a volunteer with the Boys and Girls Club of Cabarrus County, Hospice and Palliative Care of Cabarrus County, the Salvation Army and Cabarrus Crimestoppers.

In October 2007 Chancellor Brown announced her retirement effective June 2008.
