



PRE-NURSING TRACK OF THE ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE PROGRAM

The Pre-Nursing Track is designed to provide a solid educational foundation that is needed for admission to, and completion of, the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program.

The Pre-Nursing Track has the same admissions requirements as the Associate Degree Nursing Program and consists of 28 semester hours of credit that can be completed over two semesters. Students enrolled in the Pre-Nursing Track will be accepted into the ADN program at Cabarrus College at the end of the second semester of the Pre-Nursing Track if the following criteria have been met:

1. All courses in the Pre-Nursing Track have been completed by prior transfer credit for applicable courses (see criteria 2) or by completion at Cabarrus College.
2. A grade of "B" or higher is earned in the following courses at Cabarrus College (transfer credit is not accepted): BIO 100, BIO 210, and BIO 220 (see the Cabarrus College course catalog on the College website for the full course description).
3. A cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher achieved for all courses taken at Cabarrus College.
4. Successful completion of a Nursing Aide I certification program or listing on the NC NAI Registry.
5. Successful completion of American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR.

BIO 210 – Human Anatomy and Physiology I (4 credit hours)

BIO 100 – Medical Terminology (1 credit hour)

PSY 101 – General Psychology (3 credit hours)

ENG 101 – English Composition I (3 credit hours)

Elective (3 credit hours)

Total credit hours – 14

Semester II:

BIO 190 – Microbiology (4 credit hours)

BIO 220 – Human Anatomy and Physiology II (4 credit hours)

PSY 150 – Human Growth and Development (3 credit hours)

MAT 161 – College Algebra (3 credit hours)

Total credit hours – 14
